- Week by week you'll be guided by our supportive team of workshop facilitators, local historians, artists and film-makers; they'll help you use photography, film-making, the spoken word or poetry to create your very own trail.
- At the end of the project, your trail will be uploaded onto a free mobile platform. It's a chance to share your discoveries with your friends, family and neighbours – and leave your mark, so that other can follow in your footsteps.
